John Pawson

John Pawson was born in 1949 in Halifax, Yorkshire, England. After a period in the family textile business, the designer lived for many years in Japan, moving to Tokyo towards the end of his stay, where he spent his formative years in the studio of Japanese architect and designer Shiro Kuramata. Following his return to England, he enrolled in the Architecture Association in London, establishing his own design practice in 1981.

Pawson's work has focused on ways of approaching fundamental problems of space, proportion, light and materials - themes he also explored in his book Minimum, which examines the notion of simplicity in art, architecture and design across a variety of historical and cultural contexts.

When wood is converted to minimalism, pieces as balanced as Foro emerge, the new collection of tables designed by John Pawson. Dominated by a clear minimalist aesthetic, Foro is crafted from oak wood to transmit warmth, dimension and durability to any environment.

The collection completes our portfolio with pure crafts-manship and respect for nature. Its name comes from the ancient Roman culture, as Forum was the only meeting place for citizens to gather and carry their duties. A collaborative concept that has served as the starting point for the British designer, materializing it in a wooden table to encourage meetings, conversation, idea exchange and celebration.





ELECTRIFICATIONS

The collection will be able to include the new electrification solution designed by Viccarbe's engineering team. A different way to hide the cables through one of the legs, with no visible joints or screws as it works by pressure. Now, with a simple gesture, users can hide any cable, keeping everything clutter-free.

Foro can also include a new powerbox model, that integrates and respects the design of the table. A practical technical complement that does not interfere with its balanced design.
