## 1. Leading with CarbonNeutral® products and our Carbon Strategy

All Steelcase high-performance seating in the Americas are now available with CarbonNeutral® product certification - product emissions are 100% neutralized. The result is cradle-to-grave product carbon neutrality that's leading the way for our industry. We have received the highest score in our industry by CDP (formerly the Carbon Disclosure Project), and were awarded the Supplier Engagement Leader Award. We were the first in our industry to set science-based targets.



## 2. Lifecycle Assessments (LCA) and Environmental Product Declaration (EPD)

All our high-performance seating have third-party verified LCA and EPDs to share our environmental impact and help customers achieve LEED credits.



## 3. Designed and tested to last

Our seating was designed and tested to last. We conduct 80+ additional tests beyond industry standard, have a service parts program offering lifetime extension through repair and a leading warranty that covers 12-years, 24/7 multi-shift us on both parts and labor.



## 4. Minimal Packaging

All chairs default to shipping with minimal packaging to reduce emissions during transportation and delivery. Chairs packed ready to assemble compared to fully assembled means more can be shipped on fewer trucks, helping reduce carbon emissions in transport by 50%.



## 5. Waste Reduction

All high-performance seating incorporates post-consumer and/or post-industrial recycled plastic, and we offer New Black as a standard fabric or Designtex Gamut that are both 100% recycled polyester. We divert textile waste from landfills by donating fabric scraps to Public Thread in Grand Rapids to be repurposed and reused.



## 6. Industry-leading Certifications

All high-performance seating is certified IAQ Gold and BIFMA LEVEL® 3 – Steelcase leads the industry in BIFMA LEVEL® certification. Several chairs also have Declare labels.



## 7. Responsible Manufacturing

Our Seating facilities are ISO 14001 (Environmental Management System) registered, we have invested in renewable energy equivalent to 100% of our global electric power and we have the first U.S. LEED-certified manufacturing wood plant.
